CLUB RULES & REGULATIONS

1. Meetings will be held on the last Wednesday of every month. This may be changed due to special circumstances.
2. Meetings will start at 7:30 pm
3. Dues will be \$25.00 every year. All dues are due by June 30th of each year.
4. Initial dues are \$30.00 payable at the time of acceptance into Iron Horse 4x4's, Inc. You need to attend 6 (six) Iron Horse events or meetings and then be voted in by the membership at a regular club meeting.
5. All fines are equal to the amount of yearly dues.
6. No illegal off-roading, anyone caught doing so will be subject to a fine from the club. Anyone illegally off-roading on their own (not affiliated with Iron Horse) and they break down or get stuck, do not call another member.
7. No reckless driving, anyone caught doing so will be subject to fine(s) by the club.
8. Random safety checks can be given before any club event or anytime the Safety Committee deems fit.
9. Required equipment. Any member who fails to have the required equipment listed below (also described on the safety list) will face a fine of \$2.00 minimum for each infraction and will have a total of 30 days to correct all violations and to pay all fines assessed.
 - a. Valid Drivers License
 - b. Proof of Insurance (minimum liability coverage)
 - c. Fire extinguisher (securely mounted)
 - d. Tow strap (20,000 lb minimum)
 - e. Secure tow points on both front and rear. You may use a clevis as long as you have a secure place for the hookup. (around the springs, shackles, shocks, etc is not acceptable)
 - f. Spare tire and jack
 - g. All exterior lights must be in working order. This excludes auxiliary lights.
 - h. A complete and working exhaust system.
 - i. Seat belts for you and all passengers.
 - j. First aid kit
 - k. CB Radio (mounted securely)
 - l. Funnel

SUGGESTED EQUIPMENT:

Safety flares or reflectors, shovel, oil (engine, trans, differential, etc.), jumper cables, essential hand tools, anti-freeze, water, area map, WD-40, waterproof matches, knife, fuses, cell phone, tire repair kit, saw or ax, Hi-lift jack, duct tape, work gloves, carb cleaner, electrical tape, spare lug nuts, flashlight, crowbar, rain gear, spare u-joints, assorted bolts & clamps, hand held spot-light, extra gasoline, radiator stop leak, tire gauge, air compressor, clean dry socks, rags or paper towels, and spare parts you can carry.
